We are a K-1 building and we do not have M-Step data. We have 9 sections of Kindergarten and 7 sections of 1st grade. We are currently focusing on Reading fluency and Number sense for our school improvement plan.

1. We have school of choice and resident enrollment in District 7. Students are placed into classrooms based on data from the school year and parent information.
2. We are in the 4th year of our school improvement plan. We have a focus of improving the number of students who are proficient in math and literacy.
3. We are a K-1 building with 425 students

We are working to decrease the achievement gap at Bedford. We have implemented second steps in our MTSS process and we feel that the process is helping students make gains in reading and math.
