

BOARD BRIEFS

Action of the Board of Education of Dearborn Heights School District No. 7

At its Regular Meeting on Tuesday, August 4, 2015 the Board of Education discussed/ took action on the following items:

- U.S. News & World Report has ranked Annapolis High School as one of the Best High Schools for 2015. Congratulations staff!
- Superintendent John Fazer outlined the process and proposed changes to the district's sex education curriculum. The Board of Education will hold two public hearings (August 18 and September 1) before adoption of the proposed sex education curriculum.
- Authorized Superintendent Fazer to contract with Brandy Nusser as Business Manager per the agreement presented.
- Approved the appointment of Daniel Scott as Assistant Superintendent effective August 5, 2015, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract presented.
- Accepted the resignation of Dorothy Sabo, teacher, effective August 31, 2015.
- Retained the firm of Abraham & Gaffney, P.C. as auditors for the school years ending June 30, 2016, 2017 and 2018 as presented.
- Approved a resolution to call the November, 2015 Technology Bond Election and set matters to be voted upon.
- Approved the transportation agreement between District 7 and Trinity Transportation for the 2015-16 school year as presented.
- Approved the purchase/installation of SonaSpray acoustic ceiling material in the Polk School gymnasium from Stoney Creek, Inc. at a cost not to exceed \$6,150 from building & site funds.
- Approved the purchase of grades K-1 language arts curriculum materials at a cost of \$54,536.70 plus shipping & handling. Monies will be derived from the general fund and 31a at-risk funds.
- Declined a representation agreement with the Our Community Exchange Program.
